

## CMAQ Application Checklist

- 1) **To start a CMAQ Application, you must have the following information:**
    - a. Must have a [UEI Number](#)
    - b. Must have a [PA Vendor Number](#)
    - c. Company Name (DBA) must match PA Vendor Records.
    - d. Must be able to receive payment via ACH (Direct Deposit)
      - i. No Checks Issued for payment.
  - 2) **Provide timely/current estimate from dealer supplying engines or other equipment.**
    - a. Provide technical information and/or brochure or catalog information of the type of engine being acquired.
      - i. All engines must meet at least Tier 3 standards, and must be new purchases. No rebuilt engines or equipment permitted.
      - ii. Applicant must agree to destroy old engine (drill engine block).
  - 3) **Applicants cannot start work until they receive a notice to proceed subsequent to full execution of the contract.**

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### **What items are reimbursable under CMAQ Diesel Retrofits?**

**Marine Vessels:** (Meeting at least Tier 3 standards): Engines, generators, steering equipment, props, related electrical, vessel frame stabilization. Items which include propulsion and vessel navigation only.

**Cranes and Other Landside Equipment:** Engines, generators, electrical systems. Items which sustain operation or movement of the equipment only/

**Labor:** Labor costs are also reimbursable, and must be tracked by the applicant, with clear, concise records of time spent completing work. Timesheets or Excel records must be used.
